The course substitutions listed below are NIU's College of Business course prerequisites for UBUS 310 Business Core: Lecture (9), the prerequisite course for all other 300-level courses within the College of Business. In addition to these prerequisite courses and junior standing (60 transferable semester hours or 90 transferable quarter hours), students must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.75*** on a 4.0 scale. GPA will be calculated by the College of Business using all NIU coursework and all attempted transferable coursework at community colleges and senior institutions. * Students must earn a C or better in ACCY 206, 207, MGMT 217, and UBUS 223. All Business majors need a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.75 to enroll in UBUS 310 Business Core: Lecture (9), the first course taken as a junior in the College of Business.

** NIU's MATH 110 College Algebra is the prerequisite for NIU's MATH 211.

***Retention in Accountancy is competitive based on overall GPA and grades of B or better in **equivalent** courses for NIU's ACCY 206 and 207. The cumulative GPA required for the Accountancy program is a minimum 3.20 on a 4.00 scale. Students may also pass the ACCY Qualifying Exam (AQE) to be retained in the program. Retention in the Finance program is competitive based on overall GPA and satisfactory completion of UBUS 310 as evidenced by a grade of C or better. The cumulative GPA required for Finance is generally higher than the minimum 2.75 to enroll in UBUS 310 and may be closer to a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
