- Applicants must be juniors or seniors
- Applicants must be undergraduate students majoring in Aeronautical Engineering, Aerospace Engineering, Computer Engineering, **Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering**, Computer Science, Physics, or Mathematics
- Demonstrate an interest in National Defense and academic excellence
- Recipients must be U.S. citizens
- Maintain a "B" grade point average or better
- Recipients can be awarded the scholarships each year until they graduate, as long as they meet the criteria above
- Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, color, creed, sex or national origin

Selection of the applicants shall be based on:

- 1) Interest and potential future contribution to National Defense (based on the student essay)
- 2) Academic Excellence
- 3) Recommendations from AOC members

There are seven \$2,500 scholarships to be awarded. The official approval of scholarship winners will be determined at a January board meeting, when approval of the students selected by the AOC/WCC Scholarship Committee occurs.

The AOC/WCC also asks that the students selected attend the local Chapter's annual Scholarship Awards Meeting/Education Night Ceremony, on a Saturday evening in March (date and location to be announced). The purpose of this event is to award funds at the Ceremony and introduce the student recipients to family members of the scholarship honorees. It also provides an opportunity for the recipients to learn more about the AOC and Electronic Defense itself and to discuss, with current engineering professionals, the opportunities and challenges in the field. The Chapter hopes to attract students into the National Defense Industry involving Electronic Countermeasures and Defense.
