- Call prospective students to invite them to visit campus, apply for admission, and for other recruitment activities.
- Participate in virtual and in-person student panels
- Attend regular meetings and participate in ongoing training activities
- Keep current with campus and community news, events, and updates
- Assist with various recruitment and engagement activities as directed by OUA.

Northern Ambassadors should show a strong commitment to NIU and the Northern Ambassadors Program and are expected to regard their job as a professional position. They must also maintain a cumulative NIU GPA of 2.5 or higher.

Hours: Hours will be assigned by availability, experience, ability, and seniority. Each Ambassador

can expect to work between two and six hours per week including weekdays and select

weekends and daytime and select evening hours.

Salary: Hourly wages start at \$11.00 per hour.
