COMD 420 - 3 Semester Hours, Spring only  
COMD 429 - 3 Semester Hours, Spring only  
COMD 425 - 3 Semester Hours, Spring only  
Can take one additional course COMD 200, 220, 430, 493  
Total: 17 hours; Apply by February 1<sup>st</sup> for Fall Admission

**SUMMER SEMESTER**

COMD 427 - 1 Semester Hour  
COMD 428 - 1 Semester Hour  
COMD 430 or COMD 493  
Total: 5 Hours

**FALL SEMESTER**

COMD 421 - 3 Semester Hours, Fall only BEGIN GRADUATE COURSES  
BEGIN CLINIC  
Total: 11-14 HOURS

IF ADMITTED TO GRADUATE SCHOOL, START GRADUATE CLASSES SUMMER OR FALL BUT ALL STUDENTS BEGIN CLINIC IN THE FALL.

If admitted to the Graduate Program in SLP (students are informed during March/April), graduate students enrolled in clinic take 10-13 hours of courses per semester. When graduate courses are started, students must take COMD 587 (clinic) during each semester. You must complete 30 hours of academic credit (non-deficiencies) and 6 hours of clinic for graduation.
