### Special Requirements for Art History Field of Study:

1. See "Foreign Language Requirement for the B.A. Degree" in the undergraduate catalog for approved foreign language course sequences. Students who plan to go on to graduate studies should select from French, German or Italian.
2. Select one 300 Level art history course from four of the following categories:
  - Ancient
  - Medieval
  - Renaissance and Baroque
  - Modern and American
  - Islamic and Far Eastern
  - African, Oceanic, Native American and Pre-Columbian
3. During your sophomore year, select your 18 hours of cognate coursework in consultation with an art history professor. Six hours must be studio while the remaining twelve hours may be from related fields such as literature, history, philosophy, anthropology, archaeology or additional art history. Once your approved Cognate Form has been signed by your art history advisor, it must be submitted to the main art office in room AB 216.
4. For the remaining nine hours of art history electives, at least three hours must be at the 400 level.
5. The university electives are open electives, however, you may want to consider using these hours towards completion of a minor. See the Undergraduate Catalog for available minors.
