Enterprising Types with Strong **Realistic** interests enjoy business tasks that involve motor coordination; the manipulation of objects or machines; working with their hands, outdoors and/or on their feet. They may deal with products and services involving athletics, the environment, the military, or manufacturing and production. Examples of job titles include:
