**Application Deadline:** The deadline for applications is March 20, 2009. Applicants applying after March 20 will be accepted based upon availability. Applicants will be notified by April 1, 2009 with an initial deposit due by April 10, 2009.

**Initial Deposit:** Upon acceptance, an initial deposit of \$375 will be due by April 10, 2009 (applicable toward Institute fee).

**Institute Fee:** \$1,550 (\$1,650 after April 20, 2009) per person. Cost includes Chicago-Washington D.C. round trip airfare, Metropass, housing, board (all meals in DeKalb, 5 breakfasts, 4 lunches, and 3 dinners in Washington D. C.), museum admissions, and three graduate Interdisciplinary Liberal Arts & Sciences (ILAS) credit hours.
