'From Cow to Ice Cream' taught at Wright Elementary

Each year the DeKalb County Farm Bureau offers agriculture-focused lessons to first- through fourth-grade classrooms in schools across the county.

The classroom presenters are individuals involved in the agricultural industry including farmers and agribusiness people. Typically, around 150 teachers request the ag lessons.

Last year, more than 100 volunteers gave the Ag in the Classroom presentations.
