

## Directions to Grant North (C & D)

Before driving to NIU, please make sure that your assigned residence hall matches the card and map. When you exit Interstate 88, position your residence hall hang tag so it is easily visible from the outside of your car.

### **Interstate 88**

Exit the tollway at **Annie Glidden Road**. Turn **left** (west) at the first road after the toll, Fairview Road.

**Fairview Road** - Head west on Fairview Road for approximately 2 miles.

**Nelson Road** – Turn **right** (north) on Nelson Road for approximately 2 miles.

**South Malta Road** (stop sign) – Continue north (straight). The next stop sign will be Route 38/Lincoln Highway.

**Route 38/Lincoln Highway** – Turn **right** (east) on Route 38/Lincoln Highway for approximately one mile; NIU Convocation Center will appear on your left. Make a **left** (north) turn into the far west side entrance to the Convocation Center. Be in the **left-hand** lane on this drive. Make a **right** (east) on Convocation Road North.

**Convocation Rd North** - Stay in the left lane; turn **left** (north) into Parking Lot P.

**Parking Lot P** - Follow officers' and traffic assistants' directions to Stevenson Drive North; turn **right**.

**Stevenson Dr North** - Continue east to Grant Drive West; turn **left** (north).

**Grant Drive West** - Continue to Grant Drive North; turn **right** (east) to the entrance of the unloading zone.

**Unloading zone** - Follow directions of signs, officers, and traffic assistants. After unloading you will be directed to park in Lot O, W or X.

- Vehicles will be allowed to stop in a designated area only long enough to unload belongings.
  - A driver must remain with the vehicle while it is in that area.
  - After unloading you will be directed where to park in the lot.
  - The traffic patterns, signs, officers, and assistants will be in place only from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. on August 21, 2008. At all other times, regular traffic patterns and parking regulations will be in effect.
  - Although students may move in throughout the weekend prior to the start of classes, all new freshmen and transfers are encouraged to move in on August 21<sup>st</sup> to take advantage of the Welcome Days programming scheduled throughout the weekend, beginning Thursday evening.
