Preface

Herewith, the Office of Sponsored Projects presents the Fiscal Year 2010 Annual Report on external funding at Northern Illinois University. This report is designed to give readers a comprehensive and detailed view of the nature and extent of external funding support provided to faculty and staff in order to support their research, creative artistry, public service, and instructional efforts. Additionally, the report provides information on external awards that support student financial aid (e.g., Pell grants). As detailed in the Technical Notes, the report provides specific sections detailing information on research, public service, and instructional awards, array by College, Department, and the individual project. Detailed data is also provided for proposals that were submitted within FY 2010.

In previous years, we have cautioned readers about making cross-year comparisons. Both award and proposal submission data at NIU closely follow regional and national funding trends and are sensitive to those larger forces. Conversely, the scale and scope of funding at NIU are such that a very small number of large grants either being newly awarded or closing in a given year can significantly affect figures at the Department, College, or even University level. For this year and next, this caution is underlined in response to changes to the federal funding environment resulting from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). ARRA funding added over \$22 billion to the federal research and development budget. This dramatic increase in federal R&D spending, combined with the short time frame in which these funds were to be expended, created an unprecedented pool of large-scale funding possibilities. As a result, numbers of submissions and amounts of awards are substantially higher at institutions across the country, including here at NIU. As such, we have identified ARRA-related activity separately throughout this report to recognize this increase in activity.

In a further effort to allow this report to comprehensively account for external funding for the university's core mission activities, this year's report also lists funding for recognized interdisciplinary units (e.g., center, institutes, etc.) and gifts to the NIU Foundation in support of research. The report also provides a list of the current recipients of the Presidential Research Professorship and all those who received internal funding under the Summer Research and Artistry program.

We deeply appreciate the efforts of the NIU faculty and staff who submitted grant and contract applications during the previous fiscal year, and we extend our warmest congratulations to those who obtained external funding for FY 2010.

Technical Notes

Report Layout

This report is segregated into seven (7) sections. The first section, award overview, provides information about all sponsored projects awards. The following four sections are based on activity type. The activity types include research, public service, instructional, and other. The other category includes information for academic support and student services. The final two sections conclude with submitted proposals and recognition.

Intellectual Credit

For projects that have Co-PIs, the total award is allocated to the lead Principal Investigator (PI) and his/her respective department. Each Co-PI's participation on the project is indicated with a notation in the Co-PI's department to see the lead PI's entry in their department list for complete award details.

Center Credit

Involvement of a center or interdisciplinary unit is noted in the individual award sections for each activity type. Recognition for the centers and interdisciplinary units associated with an award is also provided for on page 7.

American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA)

The report also highlights activity related to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). Proposal and award activity related to ARRA is identified throughout the report as a sub-category in each section. This allows for a direct comparison of external funding activity with and without ARRA. Recognition of our seventeen (17) faculty who were instrumental in securing ARRA funding is noted as well.

Definition of Award

An **award** is a funded project for which NIU has received an official notice of award or executed contract from a sponsor. Award dollars received from sponsors that provide full funding in the first year of a multiple year project are included in the fiscal year the award was made. Award dollars received from sponsors that provide funding for each period of a multiple year project (often called incremental awards) are included under each appropriate fiscal year. As such, funding can fluctuate for a department or college depending on how a project is funded. Direct year by year comparisons should be made with caution.

Definition of Proposal

The **submitted proposal** section includes all proposals and contracts routed through OSP that requested support for a particular sponsored activity. It is important to recognize that there is no correlation between the proposals and awards in this report. This is because many of the proposals are still in pending status, meaning a funding decision by the sponsor has not been made. This is also why OSP does not attempt to calculate a firm success rate for proposals for a particular fiscal year.

Reporting Period

The **fiscal year** for NIU is July 1 to June 30. This report includes data for all awards and proposals formally processed through OSP for the FY 2010 period. An award is considered processed by OSP when it has been reviewed, institutionally endorsed (if necessary), and transferred to Grants Fiscal Administration (GFA) for account set up.

Sponsor Types

OSP recognizes five categories of **sponsors**. These categories include federal, state, corporate, public/non profit, and foreign. Proposal and award data for federal sponsors reflect both direct federal dollars and those submitted or received through an intermediate sponsor (state or other sponsor). Public/non profit sponsors include other institutions of higher education, municipalities, civic organizations, and non profit and non governmental organizations.

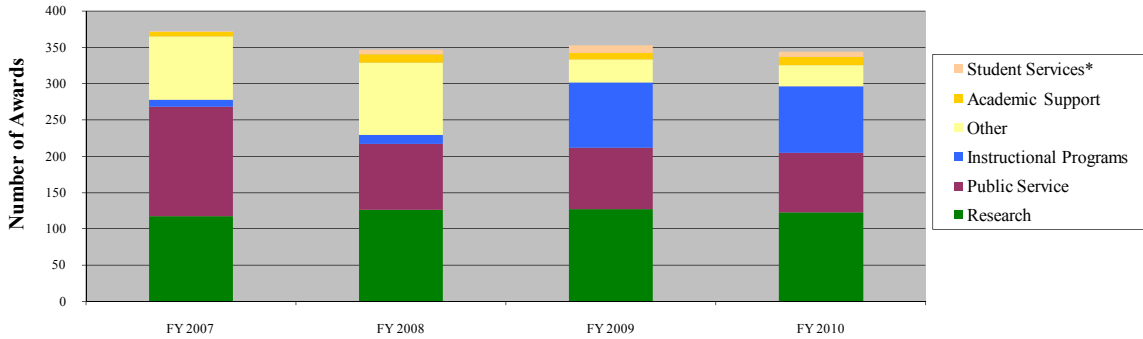

AMOUNTS AND NUMBER OF AWARD BY PURPOSE



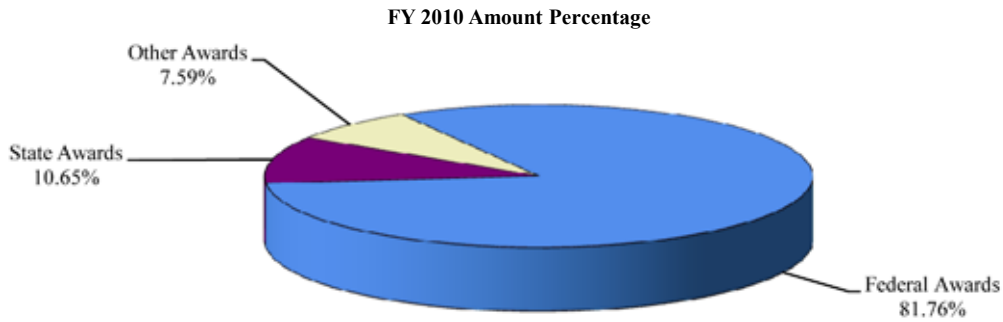

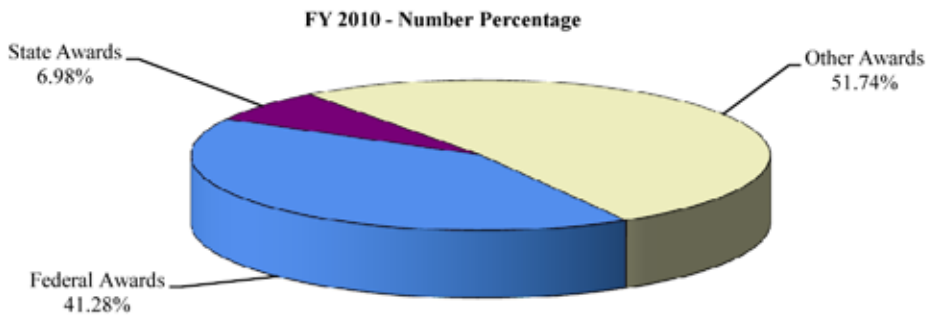

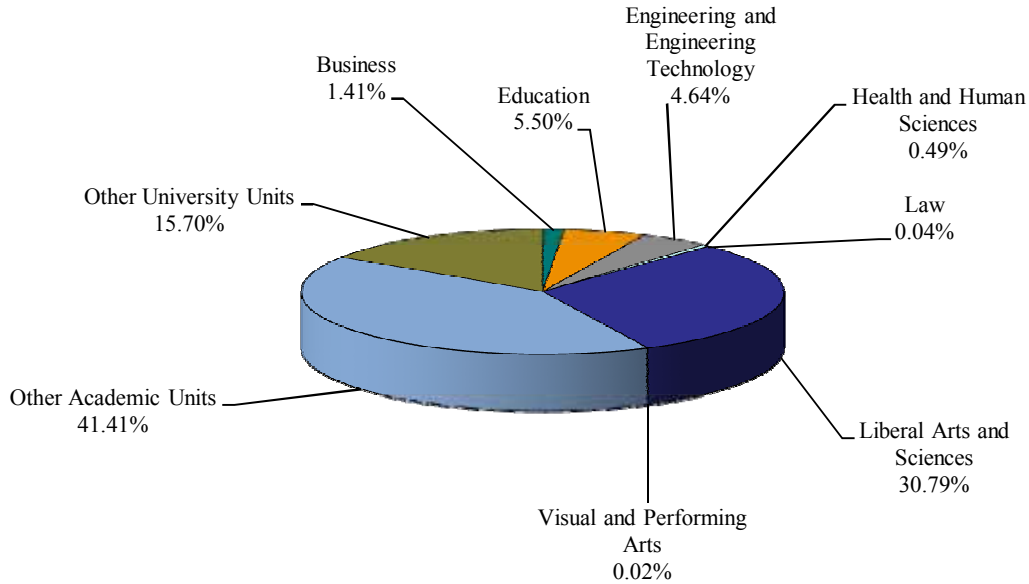

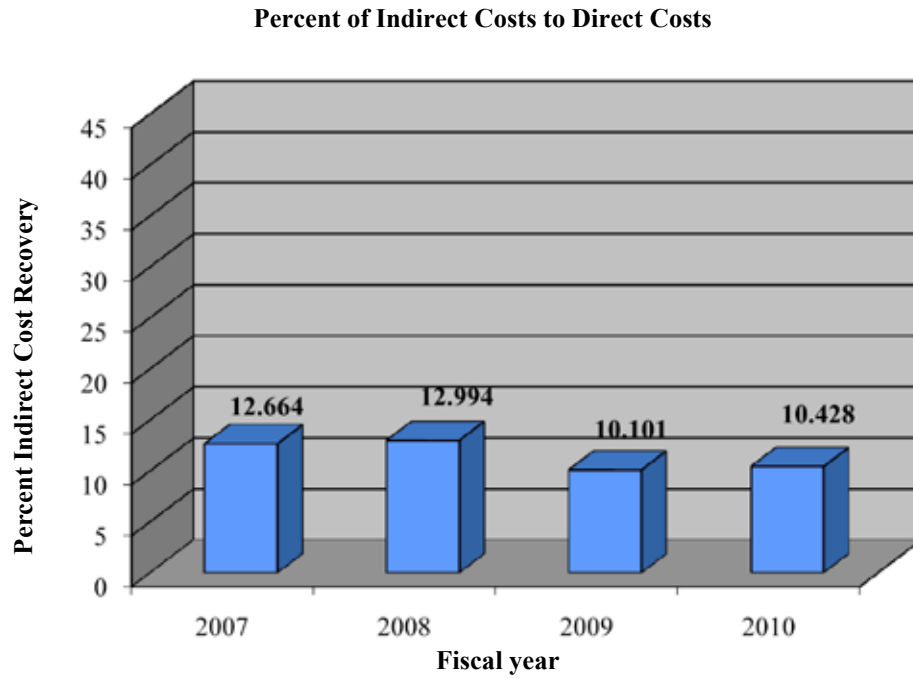

Effective Rate of Indirect Cost Return

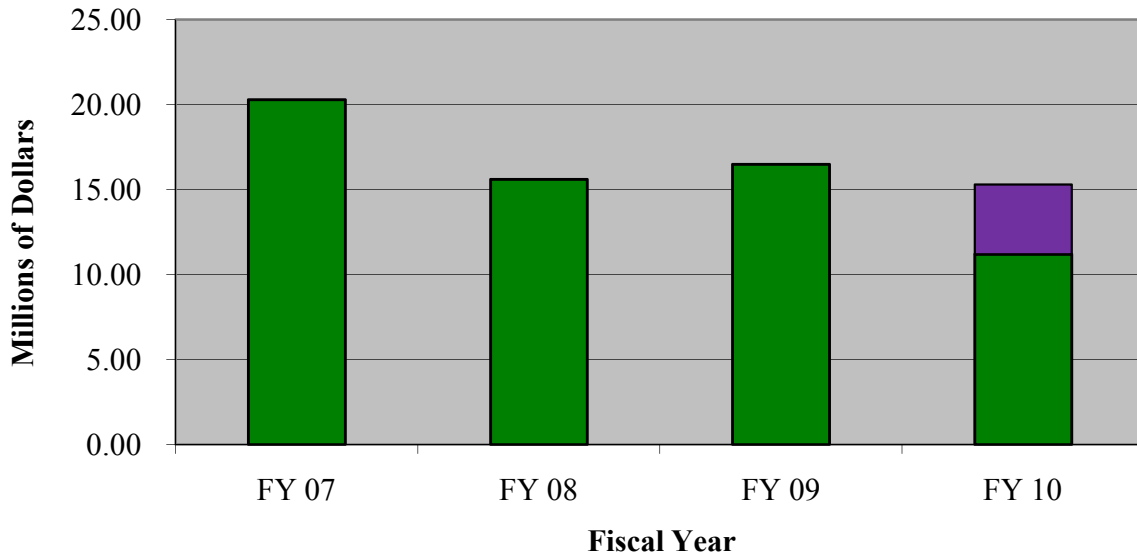


Northern Illinois University has a federally negotiated indirect cost rate of 45%. This chart reflects the average rate of indirect cost return to the university from all funding sources.

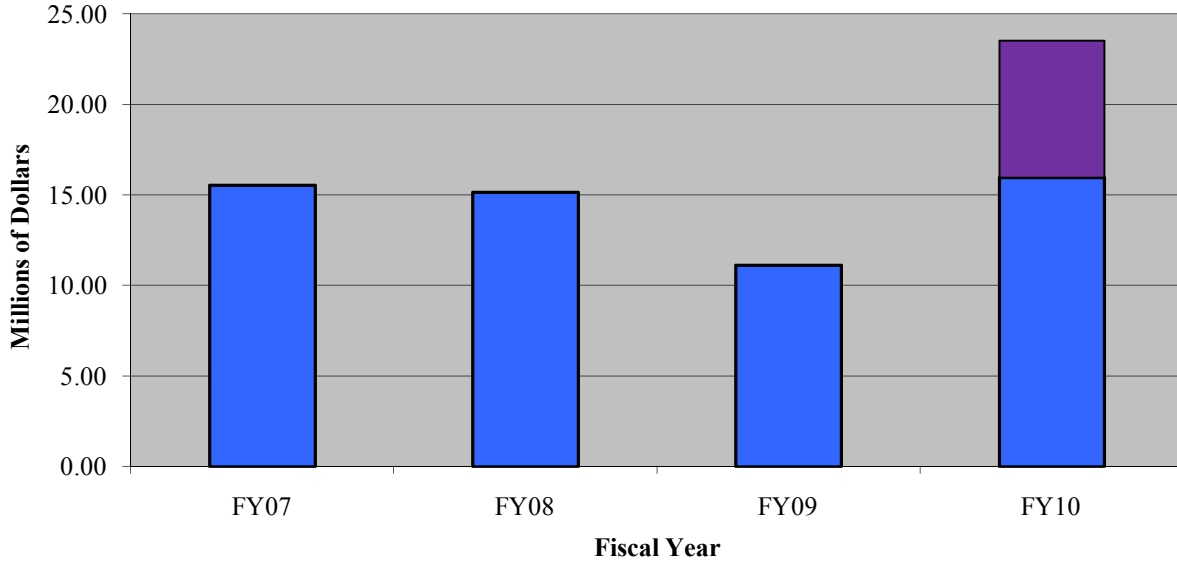

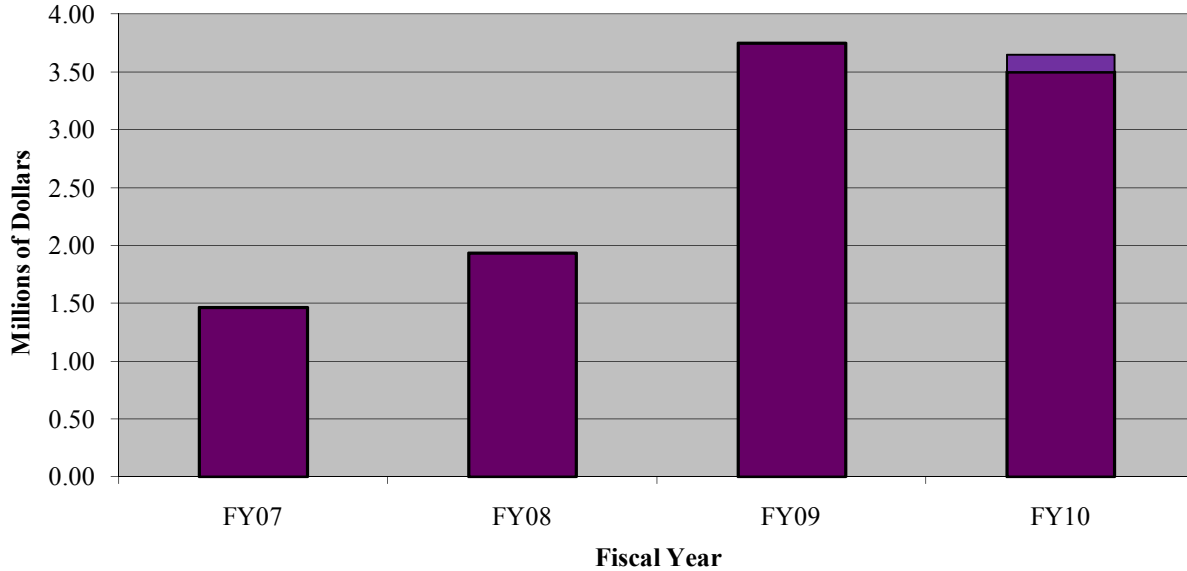

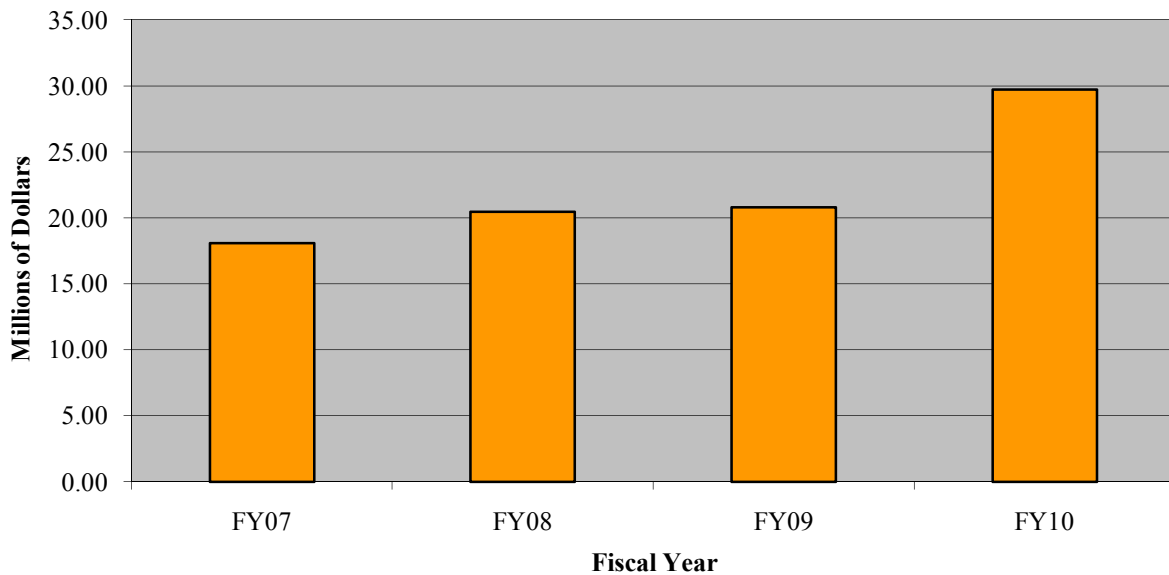

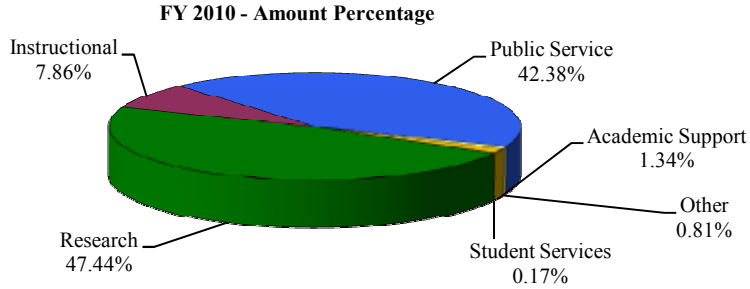

AMOUNTS AND NUMBER OF PROPOSALS BY PURPOSE



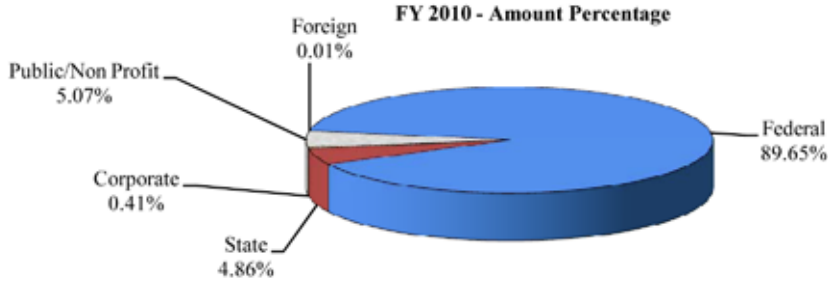

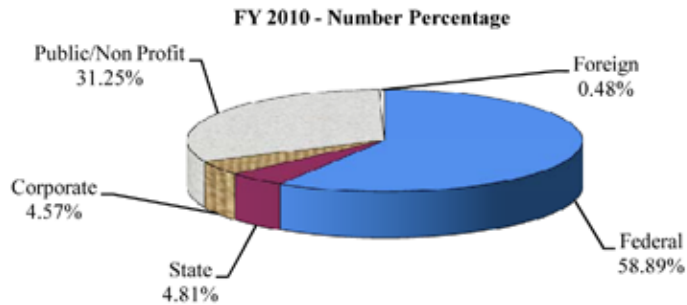
