## ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

- All teams may be Intramural Champions or teams designated by their respective institutions from any two [2] or four [4] year degree-granting college or university.
- Teams representing military installations are also eligible to compete, with all members of these teams consisting of persons that are assigned to that respective military installation.
- Faculty/Staff members of a respective institution are allowed to compete for that institution if that institution's intramural program policies permit such action in the course of operating their program on their respective campus.
- Alumni are not allowed to represent an institution regardless of any institution's intramural program policies permitting such action in the course of operating their program on their respective campus.
- No women are allowed to participate on a men's team, and no men are allowed to participate on a women's team.
- Each member of a team must meet the following:
  1. Enrolled student with a minimum of ½ full-time enrollment as an undergraduate or minimum of six hours as a classified graduate student of the representing institution, throughout the NCCS event.
  2. Not listed as a member of a varsity sport (or on "Squad List") in the same or related activity and gender during the 2008-09 academic year.
    - ✦ Exceptions will be granted for players who were listed on a "Squad List" for less than 3 weeks.
  3. Teams are limited to the following number of former varsity player(s) (A former varsity player is defined as a student who has been listed on the "school's varsity squad list" for any 2 year or 4 year college/university team for greater than three weeks):
    - ✦ Flag Football – 2
  4. Never been declared a professional player in the same or related activity.
  5. All players must present their valid University ID card prior to participation in each contest.
  6. For NCCS events that occur during an academic break, the preceding semester/quarter will be used to determine eligibility.

### NCCS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY

1. Players must be enrolled for the minimum number of credit hours, at least 45 days prior to the start of the championship event.
2. If a player is a graduating senior, and taking less than the required hours to fulfill their graduation requirements, submit a letter from the registrar along with the registration materials stating that the player will be graduating the same term as the event.
3. A professional athlete is one who receives any kind of payment, directly or indirectly, for athletics participation or who has participated with a professional team.
4. All quarter-school players must meet the eligibility requirements of 1/2 full-time enrollment for both the winter and spring quarters.

All other eligibility rules are governed by Western Illinois University's Intramural Sports program. In all cases related to written (or unwritten) rules, policies, procedures, and administration of the tournament, the director will make the final decision!

## TOURNAMENT RULES

Tournament games will be conducted under the rules of the 2008-09 NIRSA Flag and Touch Football Rules with a few exceptions. Listed below is a quick overview of the rules.

### The Game

- Playing time shall be 48 minutes, divided into 4 periods of 12 minutes each.
- Halftime shall be 5 minutes long.
- The clock will run continuously until the last 2 minutes of the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> periods, as well as all dead ball situations.

### The Field

- The field shall be 100 yards by 40 yards, including two 10 yard end zones. The length of the field shall be lined at 20 yard intervals from goal line to goal line.

### Teams

- A team shall consist of 7 players on the field for men's and women's competition and 8 players for co-recreational competition.
- To avoid a forfeit, a team must have at least 5 players to start the game in men's and women's competition (6 for co-rec).

### Start of the Game

- A coin toss shall determine the first option to begin the game.

### Substitutions

- Players may enter or leave the game an unlimited number of times. Substitutions may only enter during a dead ball.
- Substitutes must enter and leave the field from their respective sideline.

### Time-Outs

- Each team is allowed 3 time-outs per half. These time-outs shall be 1 minute in length, and unused time-outs from the first half do not carry over to the second half.

### Scoring

- Touchdown = 6 points
- Rushing touchdown by a female or passing touchdown involving a female in co-rec = 9 points
- Safety = 2 points
- Try from 3 yard line = 1 point, 10 yard line = 2 points, 20 yard line = 3 points
- Return of an intercepted Try = 3 points

### Mercy Rule

- If a team is 19 (25 for co-rec) or more points ahead when the referee announces the 2 minute warning during the 4<sup>th</sup> period, the game is over.
- The same rule applies if a team scores inside 2 minutes with this differential.

### Pool Play Tiebreaker

- Refer to the 2008-2009 NIRSA Flag Football Rule Book.

### Overtime

- In the case of a tie, a coin toss shall determine first possession.
- The options are the same as the start of the game. If additional overtime periods are necessary, teams shall alternate choices.
- Both teams will go in the same direction.
- Each team will be given 4 downs from the same 10 yard line.
- Extra points will be attempted as in regulation play.
- If the defense intercepts the ball and returns it for a touchdown, the game is over. If the interception is not returned for a score or ends the game, the ball will be placed on the 10 yard line and 4 downs will be awarded.
- Each team is entitled to 1 additional time-out only, during the entire overtime period.

### Player Equipment

- Teams must bring their own jerseys with numbers. It is a good idea to bring light and dark jerseys. If a team does not have a jersey or two teams show up with like colored jerseys, pennies will be provided. Jerseys must stay tucked in or be at least 4 inches above the flag belt line.
- Shorts or pants **can not** have pockets, any exterior drawstrings or metal fasteners.
- Shoes must be closed toed athletic shoes. Steal cleats are not allowed.
- The use of headgear, jewelry, body pads, or any unyielding or dangerous equipment is prohibited.
- Headwear containing any hard, unyielding, stiff material, including billed hats, or items containing exposed knots are not allowed.
- Flag belts will be provided.

### Sportsmanship Standard

- Any participant (player, fan, or coach) ejected for unsportsmanlike conduct will be suspended from the team's next game and must meet with the director prior to their next scheduled game.
- Any participant ejected for intentionally contacting a game official will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
- The second unsportsmanlike foul by the same player or non-player results in the disqualification of that player.
- An individual will be eliminated from the tournament upon receiving his/her third unsportsmanlike penalty.
- The fourth unsportsmanlike by the same team results in a forfeiture of the game.
- A team will be eliminated from the tournament upon receiving its fifth unsportsmanlike penalty.

#### Directions From the West

From I-90: Exit onto State Route 20 East. From 20 East, take Rt. 47 South to Rt. 38. Take Rt. 38 West approximately 15 miles to DeKalb.

**From I-88:** Take Annie Glidden Road Exit (\$1.10 cash toll, \$.55 I-Pass). Annie Glidden to Stadium drive turn right on Stadium , Chick Evans Fieldhouse will be on your left.

#### Directions From the East

From I-90: Exit onto Rt. 47 South. Take Rt. 38 West approximately 15 miles to DeKalb.

From I-88: Annie Glidden Road Exit (\$1.10 cash toll, \$.55 I-Pass). Annie Glidden to Stadium drive turn right on Stadium , Chick Evans Fieldhouse will be on your left.

#### Directions From the South

From I-39: Exit I-39 to I-88 East. Travel I-88 East to Annie Glidden Road Exit (\$1.10 cash toll, \$.55 I-Pass). Annie Glidden to Stadium drive turn right on Stadium , Chick Evans Fieldhouse will be on your left.

From SR 23: Travel north to Rt. 38 (intersection of 4th St. and Lincoln Highway in DeKalb). Turn left (West) on Rt. 38 to Annie Glidden turn right on Annie Glidden, Annie Glidden to Stadium drive turn right on Stadium , Chick Evans Fieldhouse will be on your left.

#### Directions From the North

From I-39: Exit onto I-88 East. Travel I-88 East to Annie Glidden Road Exit (\$1.10 cash toll, \$.55 I-Pass). Annie Glidden to Stadium drive turn right on Stadium , Chick Evans Fieldhouse will be on your left.

From SR 23: Travel south to Rt. 38 (intersection of 4th St. and Lincoln Highway in DeKalb). Turn right (West) on Rt. 38 to Annie Glidden, Turn right on Annie Glidden, Annie Glidden to Stadium drive turn right on Stadium , Chick Evans Fieldhouse will be on your left.
