- I. There will be a mandatory meeting for all Officials on Friday, October 23, 6:00 p.m.. The meeting will take place in Chick Evans Fieldhouse Room 128. Please make sure you are on time. Also, please make sure you are in clothes you can move around in.
  
- II. Perks for officials. I am happy to announce that there are several benefits for you working this tournament. They include:
  - a.) Verbal and written feedback from NIRSA professionals and graduate assistants on the games you work that is designed to help you learn and grow as Officials.
  - b.) Free lodging at Travel Lodge, quad occupancy. Continental breakfast included.
  - c.) Use of Recreation Center throughout the event.
  - d.) Dinner on Friday and Saturday evenings.
  - e.) Lunch on Saturday and Sunday.
  
- III. Tournament Uniforms – As tournament officials, you will need:
  - a.) Black pants or shorts (wind pants are acceptable)
  - b.) Black shoes or cleats
  - c.) Officials shirt(s)
  - d.) Whistle and Lanyard
  - e.) Two (2) penalty flags
  - f.) Black hat
  - g.) One (1) bean bag (optional)
  - h.) One (1) down indicator (optional)
  - i.) Officials coat (optional)
  - j.) Black gloves (optional)

Dress accordingly for the weekend. You will be required to have your official's shirt visible during games. Black undershirts and long sleeve shirts underneath your official's shirt are acceptable.
