APPLICANTS NEED TO CALL TO OBTAIN APPLICATION FORMS AND TO SCHEDULE AN AUDITION, PORTFOLIO PRESENTATION, OR INTERVIEW

BFA ACTING APPLICANTS CALL 815-753-8278 AND:

- Provide three (3) copies of your photograph and résumé and two (2) letters of recommendation, prior to your audition.
- Present two (2) contrasting monologues designed to show your abilities within your age range. These *combined* monologues should not exceed a total of three (3) minutes. We strongly recommend that you avoid dialect pieces (regional or national) and rôles out of your age range.
- Participate in a brief interview following your audition, in which you will be evaluated for your commitment to your personal and artistic growth in the performance area, your creativity, and your willingness to take risks and accept challenges.

BFA DESIGN/TECHNOLOGY APPLICANTS CALL 815-753-1339 AND:

- Provide ten (10) copies of your résumé and “Letter of Goals”.
- Provide two (2) letters of recommendation.
- Present your portfolio or an informal collection of visual and graphic materials that demonstrates your potential to work and create in the field of theatrical design and technology. Materials should show your *potential* as a designer or technician and may include theatre production work as well as arts projects and classroom assignments.

BA THEATRE STUDIES APPLICANTS CALL 815-753-8074 AND:

- Come to NIU to meet with BA program faculty, tour the facility, and pick up descriptions of the BA program.
- There are no requirements for enrolling in the BA program other than those needed to be accepted into the University. All applicants are welcome.
- If you wish a scholarship, then you will need to come to campus for an interview, and complete the scholarship application process.

A number of scholarships and tuition waivers are available. They are awarded to worthy students based on talent and achievement in academics, interviews, auditions, and portfolio reviews.
