As an extension of the Northern Illinois University Art Museum's mission to present contemporary art through the platform of thematic exhibitions, the Art Museum is requesting calls for entries for its 2018 – 2019 exhibition calendar.

Exhibition Theme

Data: BIG/-driven/Visualized...

This compendium of program and display delves into the array of manner in which data surrounds us, impacts us and is interpreted.

From the enormous amount of bytes of information constantly being produced, collected and analyzed; to the notion that decisions are made objectively when based on data; to the nuanced means of making numerical information comprehensible and compelling through graphic and physical representation, ***BIG/-driven/Visualized...*** explores the data in our lives.

A multidimensional exhibition about DATA to be held at the NIU Art Museum in Spring, 2019. In part, guest-curated, and in part, staff-curated; culled from the museum's and other's collections, a call-for-entry and by invitation.

Richard Siegesmund is Professor of Art+Design Education in the School of Art and Design at Northern Illinois University. He has an interest in both quantitative and qualitative research, and the design of data reports that promote thoughtful public reflection and discussion.

Eligibility

The NIU Art museum is currently accepting submissions in all media. This call is open to all artists in the United States 18 years of age or older. Two people must be able to handle and install the submitted artwork which must also fit through a single door (36" wide x 84" tall).

Entry Fee

\$30.00. Checks made out to NIU in U.S. dollars or credit card by phone are the only forms of payment currently accepted. Submissions that arrive without a fee will not be considered. Credit card payments must be made over the phone at 815-753-1936 and mailed payments must be postmarked by the application deadline announced in the Call for Entry. We accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express. Please do not e-mail, fax or leave credit card information in a voicemail as that is not a secure method of communication or payment.

Entry Formats and Required Materials

Mailed Submissions

- Resume (1-2 pages)
Typewritten with contact information

- Illustrated Image List and Statements
Typewritten with Thumbnail image
Title, dimensions, date, medium, additional artists in the case of collaboration, and insurance values.
Brief statement explaining why this work meets the exhibition theme. Applicants may submit up to 5 works in any medium for consideration.

- Flash Drive or CD must be labeled neatly with the artist's first and last name.
Submit 1 - 5 .jpg images
Format file names: LASTNAME_Title.jpg
File size 2500 px, 300 DPI

- DVD video footage of performance documentation, video or digital artwork must be labeled neatly with the artist's first and last name.
Remember to include a brief statement explaining why this work meets the exhibition theme in the Image List above.

- Entry Fee
Enclosed check made out to NIU in U.S. dollars or credit card by phone at 815-753-1936.

- Return SASE (If desired)
Appropriately sized SASE if you wish your materials to be returned to you.

Online Submissions

- Resume (1-2 pages)
Upload .doc or .pdf files with contact information

- Illustrated Image List and Statements
Upload .doc or .pdf files with Thumbnail image
Title, dimensions, date, medium, additional artists in the case of collaboration, and insurance values.
Brief statement explaining why this work meets the exhibition theme. Applicants may submit up to 5 works in any medium for consideration.

Artwork must arrive at the museum ready for exhibition. All accepted work must remain on display for the full duration of the exhibition: from March 28 – May 17, 2019. Please consider any potentially conflicting commitments with your work before making your selections for submission.

Terms

The NIU Art Museum reserves the right to maintain its established professional standards when selecting work for any exhibitions. To that end, the Museum reserves the right to accept any number of applicants, or none at all. The Museum reserves the right not to exhibit accepted work that differs significantly from images initially submitted. Notification of Acceptance

Applicants will be notified of acceptance no later than December 7, 2018

Shipping

The NIU Art Museum will provide insured return shipping after the exhibition; insured shipping to the NIU Art Museum is the responsibility of the artist. Work should arrive by March 1, 2019.

Insurance

The NIU Art Museum provides fine art insurance for all artwork while on the museum premises and during return shipping.
