

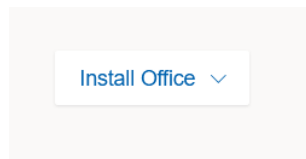

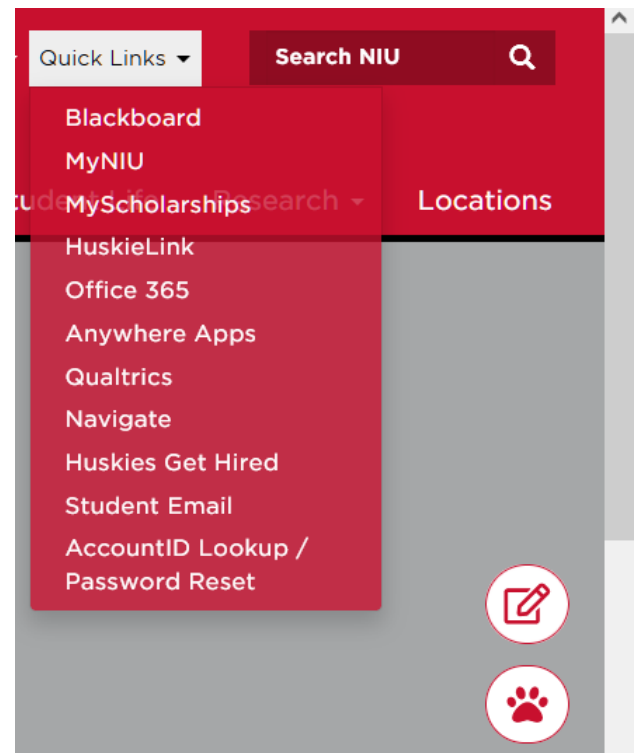

## PreLab Activity (10 points) – Complete prior to your lab session

- (a) Get Microsoft Word up and running on your PC or Mac laptop or desktop. All students have access to NIU's sitewide license to Office 365. If you do not have it installed, go to *Quick Links* on the NIU homepage ([www.niu.edu](http://www.niu.edu)) and select the *Office 365* link. You will see on the Office 365 page in the upper right hand corner an *Install Office* dropdown:



Follow the instructions and download and install it on your computer. We will have a computer lab this week, so if you have a laptop (Mac or PC) you may want to bring it to lab.



- (b) Download the “Plotting with Excel Pre-Lab” from the Physics 210 Webpage:

- (e) For the more adventuresome, try your hand at typing the following equation:

$$x = \frac{1}{2} at^2 = \left(9.8 \text{ m / sec}^2\right) \left(3 \text{ sec}\right)^2 / 2 = 44.1 \text{ m} \approx 40 \text{ m}$$
