

Chemistry Alumni Undergraduate Endowed Scholarship (CAUS)

The Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry has established the Chemistry Alumni Undergraduate Endowed Scholarship (CAUS) through the generous support of chemistry alumni and friends for the purpose of providing an award for academic achievement. Formal presentation and recognition will be made at the all-university Presidential Awards Convocation this coming fall, although the winner may be announced at the Senior dinner and monies may be disbursed beforehand.

Qualification Criteria include:

1. Applicants must be declared undergraduate chemistry majors, have matriculated at NIU for a minimum of two complete semesters and have completed a minimum of 11 credits in chemistry courses numbered 200 or higher.
2. Applicants must have at least one semester of study remaining in their program.
3. Students should present transcripts of academic work done at other institutions if these are not available in the department's files.
