

### Recommended course sequence for final two years of economics major

The sequence of required economics courses shown in the table below is recommended for economics majors so that all prerequisites for ECON 492 are completed prior to the senior year. Note that economics elective courses and other required courses may be taken throughout the junior and senior years.
