REQUIREMENTS

Undergraduates

- *12 completed hours in History
- *a minimum 3.1 GPA in History courses
- *a minimum overall GPA of 3.0

Graduates

- *12 hours completed towards an MA degree in History
- *a minimum GPA of 3.5
- *approximately 30% of the requirements completed for an MA degree

Applications for Phi Alpha Theta along with a check for the application fee can be submitted in the History Department office in 715 Zulaf Hall, 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-4:30, Monday through Friday, or else mailed to the Northern Illinois University, Department of History, DeKalb, IL 60115.

INITIATION: The Initiation Ceremony for new Phi Alpha Theta members is usually held in early May. Members will be notified of the date when it is confirmed.

GOLDEN KEY AWARDS: The Golden Key Award is presented to Phi Alpha Theta undergraduate members who graduate with at least 21 hours of History and who have achieved a minimum GPA in their History classes of 3.6.
