

HLC Accreditation

- NIU has been accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC) since 1915.
- HLC is one of the seven regional accrediting agencies recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.
- NIU's last comprehensive evaluation occurred in 2014 and the university was reaccredited by HLC for 10 years (until 2024), the maximum period possible.



HLC Accreditation Process


Open Pathway: a 10-year cycle is focused on quality assurance and institutional improvement

Final year of the cycle: Comprehensive Evaluation






Comprehensive Evaluation





Assurance Argument

- NIU will submit an assurance argument, along with materials of evidence, to demonstrate that we follow HLC's criteria for accreditation.
- The peer review team will review these materials in preparation for their on-site visit.

Evidence for the Criteria

Our evidence should do the following:

- Substantiate the facts and arguments presented in our institutional narrative.
- Respond to the prior peer review team's concerns and recommendations.
- Explain any nuances specific to our institution.
- Strengthen our overall record of compliance with HLC's requirements.
- Affirm our overall academic quality and financial sustainability and integrity.



Timeline



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Begin drafting 2023-2024 assurance argument outline

• Create template based on HLC format and institutional themes Survey evidence sources

September 2022

- December 2022



January 2023 -May 2023

- Finalize assurance argument outline
- Draft argument based on outline for each criterion
- Evidence collection and editing begins



Summer

May 2023 -August 2023

- Prepare penultimate draft of the assurance argument
- Evidence collecting and editing begins



September 2023 - December 2023

- Evidence collecting and editing continues
- 02 Make the assurance argument available for comment
 - Incorporate assurance argument comments
 - Prepare the final version of assurance argument
 - Complete federal compliance review



January 2024

- •HLC survey of NIU students
- Submit the assurance argument report to HLC


