



# **NIU Points of Pride**

## Affordability

- NIU expanded eligibility for its state-funded, AIM HIGH Huskie Pledge program, assuring more freshmen will qualify for no tuition or general fee expenses.
- For 2023-24 fall/spring semesters, **64%** of new, full-time freshmen paid **\$0 out of pocket** for tuition and fees.
- One of every three Huskies who earned their undergraduate degrees in the summer of 2022, fall of 2023 and spring of 2023 graduated with **\$0** loan debt.
- **\$27.8 million** in NIU-funded scholarships was awarded to students during FY 2023, compared to \$15.8 million in FY 2018.

## Recruitment and Retention for AY 2023-2024

- New transfer student enrollment increased by **6%**.
