

Department Student Success Initiatives Examples

- Math
 - Significant revisions to general education
 - Math Assistance Center Director
 - Math Assistance Center moving to Library
- New English Composition Director
- New Fundamentals of Oral Communication Director
- Increase in the number of free textbooks used in classes
 - Philosophy and English just recognized



Second 8-Week Courses

- Fall 2022, expanded the number of Second 8-week courses.
- 80 students enrolled after 4th week of the semester (group likely to be replacing course from which they withdrew).
- Important to track performance given that condensed course may be very difficult, particularly for struggling students.
- 67% earned a "C" or better in these courses.




Support for Failed Gateway Courses

- Introduction to Psychology course selected for this pilot.
- Students (N~200) invited to complete mastery-based modules to improve grade from "D" or "F" up to a "C" (maximum). No fees.
- Modules require practice and feedback to learn how to take notes and answer test-like questions (unlimited attempts) and then a final quiz.



Bachelor of General Studies

- Degree-completion option that allows for choice and flexibility
- Well-suited to nontraditional students or students with broad interests
- Trend of rapid growth from Fall 2019 through Spring 2022
- Currently, the 4th largest degree program in CLAS
