HSCI 460. RESEARCH IN HEALTH AND HUMAN SCIENCES (3). An introductory course in the research process for students in health and human sciences. General concepts of research and evidence-based practice. PRQ: STAT 100 or STAT 200 or UBUS 223; and CHHS major with at least junior standing; or Health Sciences Emphasis 3; or consent of school.

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*RATIONALE: Clarification of the punctuation in the list of prerequisite courses was suggested by Registration & Records. The requirement for junior standing of CHHS majors is not needed for students in the degree completion option, Emphasis 3 of Health Sciences.*
