Comprehensive Examination

Successful completion of a comprehensive examination is required in all master's degree programs described in this section except the M.A.S., the Master of Science in Taxation, the Master of Science in Teaching (Specialization in Middle School Mathematics Education), the M.S.Ed. in counseling, M.S.Ed. in physical education, M.S. in sport management, and the M.S. programs in computer science, in industrial and systems engineering, in industrial management, in management information systems, in nursing, and in sport management. The comprehensive examination may be either written or oral, or both, at the option of the department.
