  this time, it was suggested that, rather than wait for the next five-year review, the FSSocial Justice Committee be asked to conduct further review during 2022-23 with a
  specific focus on testing a bias statement.

  Advisory Committee to the Board of Trustees, Social Justice Committee, Student
  Government Association, Operating Staff Council, Supportive Professional Staff
  Council.
- Informational items will include the FS president annual report, faculty personnel advisor annual report and 2022-23 FS meeting dates.
