INTRODUCTION

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The University Press records consist primarily of the Press's publications. There are several folders of information on the formative years, 1965-1975.

HISTORICAL SKETCH

The University Council approved the establishment of a University Press on May 3, 1965. By November of that year faculty members were being asked to serve on the University Press Board and the search for a Director of the Press was being organized. The Board held its first meeting on May 26, 1966, and the first publication came out in 1967.
