#### INTRODUCTION

The University Archives acquired back issues of student publications and their records in several installments between 1966 and 1976. Current issues are received regularly. Literary rights are dedicated to the public and there are no restrictions on access to this collection.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Student Publications records series contains a number of student publications. Only two, the <u>Northern Star</u> and <u>Towers</u>, are still being published. Background information, such as constitutions and budget proposals, are included for some publications.

#### HISTORICAL SKETCH

One month after the school opened in 1899, the <u>Northern Illinois</u> appeared. It became the school news source, a monthly booklet of articles on events. In 1923, it adopted a newspaper format and began using Journalism students as reporters. Also, it expanded to a bi-weekly printing, and, then, to four days per week. It became known as the <u>Northern Star</u> in 1954 and in 1968, it began to appear five days a week. The <u>Northern Star</u> receives its funding from student fees and from the advertisements it sells.

Alternatives to the <u>Northern Star</u> have been short-lived. The <u>Quarterback</u>, which ran from 1961 to 1963, ended publication when its funding was cut. The University said its articles belonged in the <u>Northern Star</u> and its poetry in <u>Towers</u>. The <u>Edge</u>, 1964-1965, was sponsored by the United Campus Christian Fellowship. It was welcomed by the <u>Northern Star</u> as an alternative publication and a replacement for the <u>Quarterback</u>. The <u>Edge</u>, 1967-1968, was sponsored by a student group called the Edge Society. Most of its material was anti-Vietnam articles. This second edition of the <u>Edge</u> was opposed to the <u>Northern Star</u>. In 1967, the <u>Kishwaukee Surfer</u> appeared. Its primary purpose was to criticize the Student Activity Board elections and the University administration. It, too, opposed the <u>Northern Star</u>. The <u>Kishwaukee Surfer</u> was run by a person called K. Mulliner.

<u>Towers</u> is the campus literary magazine. It is sponsored by the Xi Delta chapter of Signa Tau Delta, an honorary English fraternity. <u>Towers</u> began publication in 1939, but was not published from 1941 to 1946 due to the war. It was an annual magazine until 1963, but was published twice a year through 1988. Since that date it is again an annual publication. It contains prose, poetry and art works of students. The <u>Collegiate</u> was, primarily, a humor magazine. Only one issue is in the collection. The <u>Autumn Journal</u> was a magazine that appeared twice in 1790. It was published by the Intersolopsistic Command, which had an

address in the Student Activities Center. <u>Seems</u> was a literary magazine that published works from writers outside of the DeKalb area. It appeared from 1971 to 1975 and obtained some sort of sponsorship from the English Department, though it never claimed to accept University funds. A group of students published <u>Seems</u> and the magazine was available either individually or through a yearly subscription.

The <u>Norther</u> yearbook was first published in 1900. It was funded through subscriptions until 1934 when student activity fee money was set aside for the yearbook. Format changed from a book to a three issue magazine in 1971. Publication of the <u>Norther</u> ceased a few years later, due to increasing costs and decreasing student interest. In 1985 and 1986 students put out a new yearbook, <u>The Gargoyle</u>, but costs of publication again caused this publication to fold.
