INTRODUCTION

The University Archives acquired the NIU Foundation records in several installments beginning in the mid-1960's. There are no restrictions on access to the collection. Literary rights are dedicated to the public.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The records in the collection partially document the NIU Student Loan Fund and the NIU Foundation from 1929 to 1992. Most materials belong to the NIU Foundation and include correspondence and financial accounts concerning the management of monies entrusted to the college. The researcher should note that the University Archives also holds various other record collections relating in whole or in part to the NIU Foundation history.

HISTORICAL SKETCH

The State of Illinois chartered the Northern Illinois State Teachers College Foundation in 1949 to assume trusteeship for the Student Loan Fund and anticipated scholarship at the college. As a non-profit corporation and official fund raising agency for Northern, the Foundation coordinated several programs and special projects, including Corporate and Faculty-Staff Solicitation, Senior Gift Project, and Huskie Club.

The Foundation is governed by a Board of Directors which includes a member of the Board of Regents, the University President, the Executive Vice President and Provost, the Vice President of Business Affairs, eight Alumni Representatives, eight Business, Professional and Industrial Representatives, and six faculty and staff representatives. The activities of the Foundation are coordinated through the University Office of Development with the Director of Development serving as Executive Director of the Foundation.
