


## DQ4 - I have attended workshops or training about using Blackboard for teaching


## AQ4 - How long have you been teaching with a learning management system (such as





## AQ6 - Have you used Blackboard from a mobile device (i.e., smartphone or tablet)?





## AQ7 - When using Blackboard from a mobile device, what type of device have you used?








FC1 - When I need help to use Blackboard, support is available to me




## FC2 - Specialized instruction concerning Blackboard use is available to me



## PSE1 - I feel confident using Blackboard features in general







PEOU2 - Interacting with Blackboard does not require a lot of my mental effort




PEOU3 - I find it easy to get Blackboard to do what I want it to do





## PU1 - Using Blackboard increases my efficiency when teaching






## PU3 - Blackboard helps students to be more successful in their courses



Blackboard does not have an option to turn offer right-clicking during examinations. Students are able to copy questions, or an entire exam if it is offered "all at once." This is an important problem. Test integrity is crucial for measurement of learning among current and future students. After you load a number of files in an Item, I don't know how to re-sort them. Because, in my way of doing things; an updated file goes on top of the list.

Clear exposition of math that weighted grades are doing. I can know how much weight each assignment/exam received in a weighted grade. However, sometimes the calculation is off. Maybe it's the total points for some assignments are off? Or maybe some other unexpected reason. I would like to see a simple Excel-like calculation for the weighted grade, e.g. (Hwk1/Hwk1Total\*0.05 + Hwk2/Hwk2Total\*0.15 + Mid1/Mid1Total\*0.2 + Final/FinalTotal\*0.6).

It would be nice to have the feature to drag and drop files from a desktop into a Blackboard course or from one course to another course on Blackboard. It would be nice to have built-in course evaluations.

Please Ask Blackboard to fix their text editor. It is full of nuances.

The SafeAssign feature for looking for plagiarism is not very effective. It's great for looking for students who copy from one another's papers. It is very limited for looking for plagiarism of scholarly articles. SafeAssign was telling me that a student's paper was perfectly fine (no plagiarism). When I used other approaches I found extensive plagiarism.

The rubic set-up is cumbersome and unable to be individualized for individual projects

Improved portfolio options would be helpful. Make it more user-friendly and more interesting visually.

Attendance tracking. A coordinator course tied into coordinated courses. Make a change there and it changes in the coordinated courses. Have a default column of the section the course is for. 1) needed for master course. 2) needed for lecture sections that have recitation sections associated with it. Be able to assign point values en mass to columns in Manage > Column Organization in the Grade Center. Be able to mass delete columns.

I want to use the group discussion and on-line testing, but don't know how.

Interactive rubrics that allow for a negative score (e.g., late submission penalties).

I would like it if Adobe Connect could do video better, like in Google Hangout or Skype. Adobe Connect can be clunky and difficult to use in general.

Better indications of what course I am currently in. Color changes, etc., would help. I have on numerous occasions forgotten what course I am in and have had to learn to always check the upper left hand corner of the screen to see the course number as otherwise emails are auto generated without a means to retract. Further, the automatic creation of an email to students every time I update something is frustrating, so I often avoid making corrections as it will simply generate more email.

a more enhanced version of crocdoc. Students have trouble printing their papers off with changes on them. Also, I cannot save graded rubrics to my files that are housed in BB, so if I need to access them I have to be online. That is a bit frustrating.

What features/functions that you need for teaching are not available in Bla... So far I have been very satisfied with the features available in Bb. Better self and peer evaluation. The College of Nursing needs to require new faculty to go to training, I wasn't even told I needed to use BB Fewer button clicks to get from one place to another - especially when grading assignments. BB appearance is cluttered and announcements are sequential. It would be helpful to have a "board" on which to post items (full page few). It is hard to present the full picture of a class, whether assignments or announcements. WebCT allowed for profiles/bios to be built by students. Blackboard doesn't seem to have that option. It'd be awesome if it connected to my Numbers' spreadsheets, so I'm not entering grades in two places. (none that come to mind) Since we have smart boards, I would like to see a hierarchical system view for smart boards where we could easily switch between a presentation, and at least 2 pdf's posted in the folder, as well as the Blackboard folder. Basically an advanced gallery feature. Your Welcome. Ability to easily customize the grade sheet. My grading sheets are somewhat complex and I write them in Excel. My last experience with trying to bend Blackboard to my will was less than successful. I don't know of any. Would like to be able to use peer reviews for writing assignments. Could be useful to integrate some sort of clicker system to get quick feedback during lectures. None Scheduling events, e.g. lab signups.

The calculated formula box where you actually enter the formula gets pretty wonky with various browsers at times. There has also been an issue with the formula ignoring or parentheses when applying the order of operations.

The eportfolio feature is still lame. We do the entire program assessment using Bb eports, and they still will only take a snapshot of an iteration; students cannot use them in the living, evolving way that eportfolios are supposed to work.

Attendance Tracker

Blackboard's dependence on numerical data for grading is really quite irritating. I use a standards-based grading system in some of my courses, and Blackboard claims to allow you to enter grades that are text (in other words, letters that are not in the traditional ABCDF structure and also not numbers.) You can enter the garden center and edit grade columns to take text input, but when you create gradeable assignments you can't select that as an option (it makes you assign a number of points to the assignment) and you can't enter the text grade directly when grading a document in-line (you have to assign a number there to the grade as well.) I end up having to create an assignment, then go into the grade center to change the grading structure for the column to Text. When grading I then have to assign 0 points to the assignment and run a second tab in my browser to click over and change the 0 when it appears to whatever the actual Text letter grade is. Similarly, because it believes all grades have to comply with certain structural expectations the mobile app for the class misreports grades when students use it. Very frustrating function issue.

An easier and smoother way to hold online courses.

Good question. I don't know what I don't know.

A survey that is not anonymous -- so people can let me know their opinion about a question when I need to know who they are to accommodate their wishes. Now I have to use a "test" to do that, but it is not mean to be an assessment, and I don't think using a "test" sends the right message.

I use TopHat b/c it is not have a clicker function.

Interaction with Revel would be great.

1. Uploading/editing multiple files at one time, not each file separately like it's done now. 2. More freedom to organize course page: the pre-sets are pretty limiting.

This might already be a feature that I don't yet know how to use, but I wish I could create a test/quiz that provided immediate question-by-question feedback, rather than all at once at the end.

The ability to upload multiple files without java. The fact that the blackboard app requires java to upload more than one file is ridiculous - java apps for the web are not widely used anymore, and one of the main browsers (Chrome) no longer supports them at all. This led me to use my second default browser (Safari), for which the java app crashed. There should be simpler solutions

Drag and Drop files to build content. Building a course readings list one file at time is antediluvian I intend to test the ability to hold on-line synchronistic classes with live video interaction in the future. Students are asking for this. NIU is increasingly a commuter campus. Students struggle with the time commitment to drive to DeKalb.

A decent discussion board would be nice

Clicker questions for the classroom- don't know if that could be available through BB.

I would like to understand better how BB can give a student a projection of what their final grade will be by points earned to date. I think the capacity is in the system, I just haven't figured out how to make it work. I would also like to feel confident that BB can translate my gradebook for a large lecture course (176 students) into the MYNIU grade reports. Finally, I think we should be able to load media clips into BB without worrying about Copyright holders--it's a closed system for educational purposes, not an attempt to infringe copyright.

Analysis results of learner analytics

Dealing with groups is not very intuitive in blackboard. I tried to use the feature and it just wasn't doing what I intended it to do. Some features are particularly not user friendly, formatting the text for instance is one of them.

An online classroom feature that works and is reliable. My students have missed a great deal of instruction this semester due to the problems with BB Collaborate Ultra.

I post materials of very different types. Since all I can do is post them as 'files', they all have the same icon. There is nothing to differentiate between readings, lecture slides, software, etc. The result is visually unappealing and utterly confusing when actually looking for a type of resource. This could be fixed by having a drop-down menu when uploading a file and a set of 5-10 icons...

If Blackboard were like Slack with a secure way of posting grades. By "like Slack" I mean with that kind of crisp, intuitive UI, and with a communication mechanism that operates like a direct message service. I would love for students to be able to quickly post a question about a reading and get an answer from other students.

I would like to see student ability to mash and embed from their office365 in discussion boards rather than having this feature unavailable to them.
